North Georgia Children's Center, Inc., is a new not-for-profit organization that is forming to provide support for children with developmental disabilities and their families. The purpose and goals of this organization are multi-fold.

- (a) To serve the needs of children with autism and other developmental disabilities, their families, and their communities, through direct services to children and families based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA);
- (b) To educate parents, school system personnel, and the communities of North Georgia on autism and related developmental disabilities, on supporting treatment options, and on the concepts, value, and effectiveness of Applied Behavior Analysis;
- (c) To provide funding assistance to needy families to enable their access to therapy and other services through fundraising, grants, and community partnerships;
- (d) To act as a private school as an alternative to public education to educate children with autism and other developmental disabilities;
- (e) To solicit contributions of any kind to this Corporation to support the purposes of the Corporation, provided that the Corporation has the power to reject any gift made subject to any condition that the Corporation believes to be in conflict with its policy or the best interests of this Corporation; and
- (f) To make distributions to organizations that themselves qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
